BICTON PARK BOTANICAL GARDENS

We head to Bickton Gardens with a comfort stop on route. Once you have got to Bickton Gardens you can explore the Italian Garden which is the centre piece of Bickton, it is almost 300 years old and still provides the park's most famous view, across vast terraced lawns to a tiered fountain, standing directly in line with a distant obelisk. There is also the American & Stream Gardens which have some of the loveliest trees in the park including the infamous Chinese handkerchief tree. Other gardens include the Mediterranean & Rose Garden, the Fernery & Shell House, the Hermitage Garden, and the Pinetum & Arboretum. You can also take a trip down memory lane and visit the Countryside Museum and see many restored artefacts and machinery of rural life from days gone by. The museum is packed with nostalgic delights for all generations including traction engines, vintage machinery, traditional tools, and domestic memorabilia. There is also the glasshouse to explore so you can start in the Palm House, then go to the Tropical House and finally the Arid House. Finally do not forget to take a ride on the Bickton Woodland Railway.
