The Bishop's Palace and Gardens has been home to the Bishops of Bath & Wells for over 800 years and this stunning medieval palace, along with its 14 acres of gardens is open for you to enjoy. Surrounded by a breath taking moat, you can cross a flagstone drawbridge, walk under the portcullis and experience a true hidden gem. The Bishop's Palace dates from the early thirteenth century when Bishop Jocelin received a crown licence to build a residence and deer park on land south of the Cathedral of St Andrew.

The Bishop's Palace Garden Festival returns to celebrate its 6th year within the 14 acres of stunning gardens. The South Lawn will be filled with stalls including nurseries, food & drink, garden gadgets, gifts, sculptures and more as well as live music, hands on demonstrations, workshops and flower installations.

If you have time you may also want to go into Wells as they have a local market on this day as well.
