## SUDELEY CASTLE

We take you directly to Sudeley Castle with stunning views of the Cotswold Hills. With royal connections spanning a thousand years, Sudeley Castle has played an important role in the turbulent and changing times of England's past. Sudeley Castle remains the only private castle in England to have a queen buried within the grounds - Queen Katherine Parr, the last and surviving wife of King Henry VIII, who lived and died in the castle. Henry himself, Anne Boleyn, Lady Jane Grey, Queen Elizabeth I and Richard III have all played part in Sudeley's story. King Charles I found refuge here during the Civil War, following its "sighting" on Cromwell's orders at the end of the Civil War, Sudeley lay neglected and derelict for nearly 200 years. Sudeley Castle and Gardens is now the home of Elizabeth, Lady Ashcombe and her son, daughter and their families. During your visit there is much to see and do including 10 magnificent gardens, the Castle exploring its history, look at the exhibitions and visit St Marys Church which is the resting place of Queen Katherine Parr
